### **Background**

Workplan of the Regional Working Group on Governance for 2017-2019 and the Project Workplan for 2017 were approved by the first meeting of the Interim Commission Council last July in 2017. One of major deliverables of this RWG-G in 2017 is to build institutional framework including YSLME Commission. Based on decisions of the Interim Commission Council, implementation of activities of these workplans need to consider the following factors:

- Significant delay of the second phase of the Project and delayed establishment of the RWGs and the urgency of implementation of activities immediately;
- Review of planned activities carefully by RWG members who have not participated in the first meeting of the MSTP;
- Maximizing cooperation and coordination among experts of RWGs from participating countries.

In this regard, the 1<sup>st</sup> meeting of the RWG-G will be held in the Interim Commission Secretariat in Songdo, RO Korea on November 21-22, 2017. The meeting will be organized by the Secretariat.

### Objectives and Outcomes of the meeting

The 1st meeting of the RWG-G is expected to achieve the following objectives:

- To review and refine activities of RWG-G and workplan for 2017-2019 as necessary and agreement on the work arrangement among RWG members;
- To agree on the concept paper on roadmap revised with suggestions by members.

It is expected that the workshop could provide the following tangible outcomes:

- 1) Revised workplan activities proposed in the 3-year workplan and agreed work arrangement among RWG-G members;
- 2) Adopted concept paper on roadmap with revision which will be submitted to the 2nd MSTP meeting
- 3) Agenda of next RWG meeting
